Invested in Connection: Cheryl's Journey with Polar Broadband

Cheryl Osowski was no stranger to the challenges of rural infrastructure. Together with her husband, Robert, they had long dealt with unreliable, underperforming Internet service in their rural North Dakota home. They relied on a wireless connection, mounted four miles away on the water tower in Minto, that was slow, intermittent, and incapable of supporting basic needs, let alone their home security system, solar power integration, or small business operations.

That changed in 2023, when Polar received a \$12.1 million American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) grant, with a \$4 million match from Polar, to expand broadband services to underserved areas in Walsh, Grand Forks, Traill, and Steele counties.

A Voice for Rural Residents

Cheryl didn't just benefit from the grant initiative; she championed it. She became an active voice in Bismarck, speaking to legislators on behalf of Polar and advocating for increased rural broadband funding. Recognizing the collective strength of her community, she even launched a letter-writing campaign with her neighbors to pressure decision-makers to act.

Their area had been neglected by existing providers unwilling to invest in fiber upgrades, leaving residents behind in a digital world. "We were basically forgotten," Cheryl recalls. But through persistence and collaboration, change came.

"Cheryl didn't wait for change; she led it", said Karl Blake, CEO of Polar. "Her persistence and grassroots advocacy helped shed light on a neglected area and turned momentum into action. We're proud to have customers like Cheryl who not only believe in our mission but actively help push it forward."

Connecting Their Lives and Business

Today, the Osowskis are connected through Polar's fiber-optic service, transforming both their home and work lives. Their business, REO Truck Repair and Salvage, depends on reliable Internet. Surveillance systems installed by Polar allow them to monitor their 13-acre property remotely, with mesh extenders providing coverage across several outbuildings. Their solar-powered Generac system also relies on WiFi for integration.

Beyond the internet, the Osowskis now also have landline services through Polar, replacing the unreliable copper wiring that was prone to weather-related outages. "It's night and day," says Cheryl.

A Co-op that Cares

For Cheryl, Polar's value goes beyond just technology; it's about trust and shared purpose. "I appreciate the coop model, you're invested in its success," she says. "With Polar, members get capital credit payouts and support from local professionals who live in the communities they serve."

This local connection proved especially critical in June 2025.

Caught in a Scam, Saved by a Local Partner

On the morning of a major plane crash in India, Cheryl went online to check updates. Suddenly, her screen was taken over by a pop-up that looked like Microsoft Defender, warning her of a security breach and urging her to call a number.

Although tech-savvy, she uses multi-factor authentication, keeps her browsers updated, and practices strong password habits, this scam was convincing. As a supposed Microsoft technician guided her through downloading a remote access tool, Cheryl felt uneasy. Thankfully, she acted on instinct and called someone she trusted: Kyle Halvorson at Polar.

Once her system was cleared, she contacted her Florida bank to unfreeze her account, assuring them she had spoken with her service provider and there was no longer a threat. The representative, cautious of potential scams, asked how she knew she was truly speaking with Polar. "I'm on a first-name basis with my provider," Cheryl replied. "They're real people, sitting in Park River, ND, waiting to help me."

More Than a Utility, A Community Lifeline

Cheryl's story is a strong testament to how local cooperatives can make a difference. "Polar should be the choice," she says. "They're here to serve you first as a rural customer. Their reason for being is to serve the places others ignore. We are lucky."





Avoid Online Scams

1. Be Skeptical of Unsolicited Pop-Ups and Messages

- Never trust pop-ups that claim your device is infected or needs urgent repair.
- If it tells you not to close your browser or turn off your computer, that's a red flag.
- Legitimate companies (like Microsoft or Apple)
 will never contact you this way.

2. Never Call the Number in the Message

- Scammers often include phone numbers that appear legitimate.
- Always go to the official company website and contact support directly if you're unsure.

3. Don't Give Remote Access to Anyone You Don't Know

- No real tech support will ask for remote access unless you initiated the support request.
- Allowing remote control opens your device to full compromise.

If something feels "off," it probably is. Reach out to someone you trust, whether a friend, a local IT expert, or your internet provider.
